# KTN – iX, Innovation Exchange

- Cross-sector program supporting innovation transfer by matching industry challenges to innovative organisations from a wide range of sectors.
- Putting large businesses with technical needs in contact with organisations who have innovative technology, for faster development of novel solutions.
- Innovators get the opportunity to work with large corporates on a commercial basis via a simple submission of their ideas.
- The challenge owner selects the ideas that best fit the challenge and then looks at how they might collaborate on a commercial basis.

# European Framework Programmes

Funding programmes created by the European Union/European Commission to support and foster large scale collaborative research with more than 3 EU partners.

[Horizon 2020](#) is the current Framework Programme. It began in 2014 and had its last call for proposals in 2020. Total budget for Horizon 2020 was ~ €80Bn

[Horizon Europe](#) is the successor to Horizon 2020 and the Work Programme is due to be published in 2021 (~March/April)

- Horizon Europe has an agreed budget of €95.5Bn
- The UK has agreed to Associate to Horizon Europe
