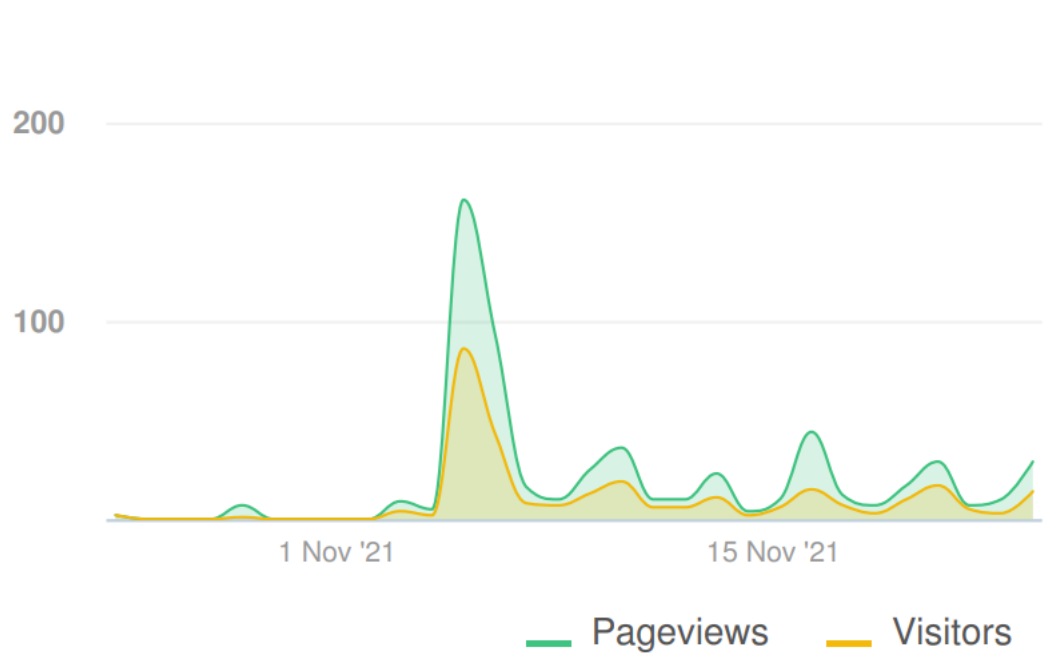
- Started with Dorset and East Devon FLAG

- Options paper for Phase Two



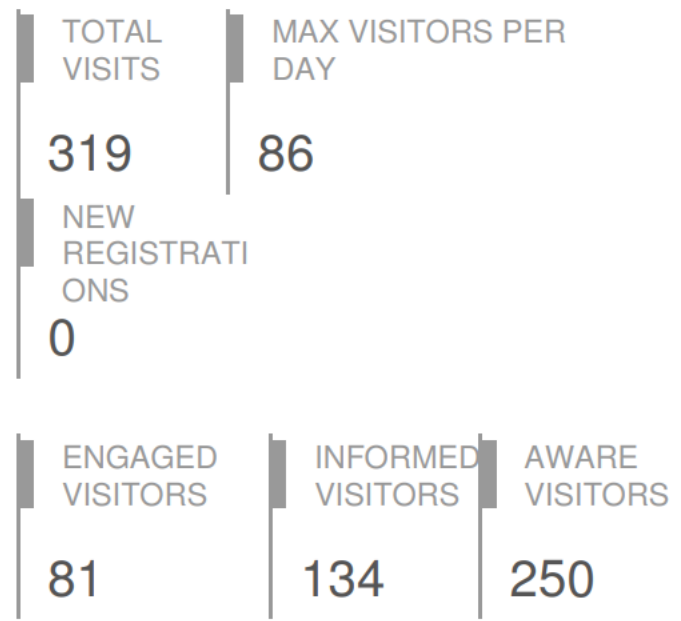
